(a) News Internship Program – Spring 2009

The News Director and the Assignment Editor, who oversee and manage the internship program and evaluate the interns' performance, supervise interns. During the internships, which usually last for one semester, participants are exposed to and trained in the skills necessary to develop a successful career in the broadcast news industry, including assisting with remote broadcasting, researching and writing news copy, attending daily meetings of the news staff, and learning various technical skills. There were twelve interns during the period covered by this report.

(b) News Internship Program – Summer 2009

(d) Co-Sponsor Business Show/ Job Fairs

On April 23, 2009, WICZ-TV co-sponsored the Greater Binghamton Business Show, a well-attended annual event that covers the Binghamton/Endicott/Johnson City, NY region and represents a diverse cross-section of businesses providing products, services, and resources to Greater Binghamton and the world. The General Sales Manager, who has substantial responsibility in the making of hiring decisions, accepted resumes and answered questions about careers in the television industry and various aspects of broadcast employment.

(d) Participation in Business Show/ Job Fairs

In June and December 2009, WICZ-TV participated in the two Project Homecoming Job Fairs, which were sponsored by the Broome County Chamber of Commerce. The job fairs were designed to attract college students who were home for the holidays and summer breaks. The station assisted in publicity by featuring news stories on the events. The Programming Director, an individual who has substantial responsibility in the making of hiring decisions, accepted resumes, interviewed attendees, and answered questions about careers in the broadcasting industry.

(e) Technical Training Program

WICZ-TV, in cooperation with National Association of Broadcast Employees and Technicians (NABET) Local 26, has developed a training program for current personnel, designed to enable them to acquire skills that could qualify them for higher-level positions. Our recently hired news department director-photographer, and one of our part-time editors, received training in the program during the period covered by this report. The program is conducted by NABET personnel using WICZ-TV equipment, and teaches the technical skills required for advancement both inside and outside of the WICZ-TV employment unit.

(e) Participation in Events Sponsored by Educational Institutions

WICZ-TV staff and managers have visited and spoken to school classes throughout the viewing area about careers in broadcasting.

September 2009 - WICZ-TV's News Director spoke to student groups at the Broome-Tioga board of Occupational and Employment Services (BOCES) about skills needed to pursue a career in television.

(f) Association with Educational Institutions

WICZ-TV's News Director serves on the Trade Board on the Broome-Tioga Board of Occupational and Employment Services (BOCES). The board aims to keep BOCES teachers informed about trends and news related to their subject areas. WICZ-TV's News Director has communicated regularly about changes in the broadcasting industry and in the station's newsroom.

(g) Association with Educational Institutions

WICZ-TV's Corporate Director of Programming and Operations is on the Advisory Board of ITT Technical Institute. The board meets quarterly and discusses curriculum, internship opportunities and specific potential employment needs.
